Pacific Power owns and operates the Merwin, Yale and Swift No. 1 hydroelectric projects on the North Fork of the Lewis River. In late 2004, a wide-ranging settlement was reached among state and federal resource agencies, Native Americans, counties and civic groups for new project operating licenses. In late June 2008, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) issued new federal operating licenses which provide 50 years of continued operation of the hydroelectric projects. As part of this agreement, we committed to hold an annual public open house on our high-runoff procedures and flood management coordination for the river.

This is the sixth of these annual events. In an open house format, Pacific Power and agency representatives will provide information on:

- how residents can obtain public information; and
- how we coordinate activities with public emergency management agencies during high-runoff conditions.

We invite all interested parties to attend.
