Lower Columbia College Woodland Center, in partnership with the Cowlitz County Health Department, continues to offer Food Handler Health Card testing at Lower Columbia College in Woodland. Testers must have photo ID with them at the time of the test. Cost for the test is \$10, cash only please. The health card is valid for two years in all counties in Washington State. All testers, new or renewing, are required to view a 25 minute training video. Allow at least one hour to view the video and take the test. Please, no children or cell phones. Testing is available at Lower Columbia College Woodland Center at 650 Goerig Street, Suite F in Park Plaza. Testing hours are Monday–Friday from 8–11 a.m. and 1–4 p.m.
