- Special event, sign and street closure permits completed and turned in
- Contact made with KRB Design – will create and print posters
- Called Nazarene Church about shuttle/parking for Cemetery Tour – Andrea will check with the new pastor
- Porta-potties ordered - will also have hand washing station
- 150 Lapel pins received – sell for \$2.00
- Clark County Health Department contacted and agreed Centennial Committee could apply for one food permit as long as local teams/organizations were placed in one row. Each booth would be required to have their own food handler's card. Offered to Little League to have booth but did not hear back, then emailed Jacki at the High School to have her ask coaches/teachers if they want to have a fundraiser
- Met with LaCenter representative and there will not be a City-2-City bike ride nor will there be a movie on Saturday night in LaCenter. They still plan to have fireworks on Sunday if anyone wants to join in
- Golden Grads will have a display of past reunions and information, the Historical Society will be available to scan photos/documents, a button authority will have a display including Civil War era buttons, need to contact Charlotte about the Heritage displays and antique equipment.
- Committee decided it would be better to have dance on Saturday night due to work schedules and have it be the grand finale. Ron Onslow to follow up with Jane Cooper.
- Outhouse Competition: Desmond has three builders and will look for a fourth. Ron will pass on his ideas.
- Fashion Show: Phyllis has models lined up. Will need to be at Old Liberty between 9 and 9:30 – show to start at 11:00. Working with kids to see if they can wear ancestors/relatives clothing. Moved Best Costume to 12:30 to give the models the chance to compete if they want to. Award now at 2:30 after the panel discussion. - Heritage Committee: need to follow up with Charlotte about displays, cookbook and panel discussion
- Walking Tour – Cathy and Lorraine have been out and about and noting information about businesses and residences. Cathy & Dan have been discussing the outline. Cathy called the Reflector and they will print 1,000 copies for \$266

- Music: Michelle tried to get a commitment from the Barbershop group from the Methodist Church but they said it was too early. She will follow up again. Sweet Adelines and Opus Music on track
- Historical Book: Dan has begun the layout and is at 15 pages. Needs to add photos, etc and someone to proof read – look for volunteers
- Games: Therese will look through magazines to order supplies for various games and discussed coin options for the scramble
- Cemetery Tour: Nancy has secured the Vancouver Ambassador's to play various residents of the cemetery. Coffin Cruiser's have agreed to participate. Nancy is checking to see about shuttle
- Time capsule: Need more stuff! Library is having available to the kids to make their own time capsule with paper rolls
- Cards of the decades: Warren is working on finding vehicles
- Refuge tour with John Burrow: tour should take approximately 1 to 1 ½ hours. Participants park at the Hunter's Station on the River "S" Unit, walk ¾ mile to John and he will have information set up and give a talk, then walk ¾ miles back. USFW to have information at the Hunter's station.
- Kayak paddle tour – Gail will have tours go out with guides for minimal cost
- LCREP canoe tour – Pre-registration will be required as limited seating is available
- Commemorative items: no report on ornament, Lapel pins available
- Postcard/stamp: Leanne has received most of the photos and Allene will get the last of the info to her. Post office will be available at the Community Center for the cancellation stamp and it will then be available for 30 days at the post office
- Community Photo card: Allene working with Dan to set up time, place and photographer
- Sponsorships: Allene and Dave will work on obtaining sponsor for entire celebration and for events such as the children's games. Need costs for each activity so they know what is needed.
