

City of Woodland Community Garden Guidelines and Rental Agreement

1. It is the gardener's responsibility to maintain plant or mulch their garden plot. If your plot is not worked or attended within 14 days after opening, it may be reassigned without a refund.
2. Gardeners who fail to maintain their plot and have a consistently weedy or unattended plot will be contacted and must clean up their assigned plot within 5 days. Continued inactivity will be viewed as abandonment of the garden plot, and the plot will be forfeited without refund.
3. Each person and/or family will be allowed to lease no more than (2) two plots. Priority will be given to City Residents during the first two (2) week period of each year, or as determined by the Clerk-Treasurer Department. If, after a date determined by the City, you will have the opportunity to lease additional plots.
4. Gardeners responsibilities and courtesies will include; **a)** maintenance of shared paths to adjacent to your plot, to include no digging in paths, keeping paths rock free and keep paths unobstructed; **b)** no smoking within the garden area; **c)** removal of trash and litter from your plot and taken home for disposal (**there is no garbage service onsite**); **d)** wind up hoses and return to the facet site when finished watering; and **e)** no tires allowed at the gardening sites.
5. Registered gardeners are responsible for keeping the City of Woodland Community Garden program informed of any address or phone number changes. Changes should be reported to the City at (360) 225-8281.
6. The use of pesticides is highly discouraged on garden plots; however, the Community Garden program does not restrict the use of pesticides. Each gardener is responsible his or her application methods.
7. **Absolutely** no expansion for gardens beyond your designated and staked out plot(s) will be tolerated. Removal of marker stakes and twine will result in forfeiture of your plot and no refund will be given.
