Treasurer's report:

1. Erin moved to transfer \$4000 from the checking account to a CD; seconded by Joyce.
2. Calendar report--16 left. Suggestion was made to put some at the lilac gardens if they will allow this.
3. Discussion of proposed tea party next year. Venue still under discussion. Date set for Saturday. April 30th. We still need teapots, spoons, forks and trays.

New Business:

1. 2012 will be the 100th anniversary of the library building being opened Erin proposed that we should have some kind of celebration to involve all age groups in the community. A suggestion was made to work with the historical society on this.
2. Al has information on an economic stimulus grant and will follow through on applying for this grant.
3. Peggy reported that the mayor of Woodland wanted to increase speed of the Internet at the library as clients can only reserve computers for one hour which is not sufficient when they are so slow.
4. Dinner for FVRL board will be held on Monday March 8th, in the high school library. Set up will start at 3:30 PM.

Art in the Park:

Iris has been getting phone calls from artists interested in this activity. Members decided on September 11th as the date for this event. There was discussion about purchasing a banner (approximately \$315) to advertise this but no decision was made. Iris moved (Erin seconded) to charge artists \$30 this year instead of the \$50 two years ago.

Membership report:

Sharon has had 12 responses to letters sent out. Iris suggested that Sam talk to Chamber about the growth in the use of the library.

For Your Information:

Erin reported that Margaret Hepola was honored by the Washington State Legislature for her philanthropic works which include support for the library.
