

Minutes for April 22 meeting

Old Business

Al reported on the progress of the grant we applied for last month. We will know by May 4 if we get the grant. If the library does get the grant, it would create instant new jobs in the community and provide a catalyst for people to go down town.

In February we had talked about getting Imagio to perform at our planned celebration for the centennial of the library building in 2012. Erin reported that the cost of this would be prohibitive (\$10,000).
