LIBRARIAN'S REPORT

Summer reading is under way. To date 280 children aged 0-11 have signed up, as well as quite a few teens. Justin, Blake and Thia have been able to publicize the summer reading in the schools to a greater degree this year.

The first performance of the summer will be June 26th. B.J. the Clown will perform from 3-3:45 pm. Then the winners and honorable mentions in the book mark contest will be celebrated. Justin will be buying frames for the presentations. He would like volunteers to help. (Be there at 2.) Diane, a part-time assistant has left, and Justin will be able to replace her with a part-time Senior Library Assistant. That person will be responsible for the Teen/Tween programming, and the library will be able to add an additional book discussion. The new person will also assist Thia with the school-aged programming and fill in for story times as needed.

The planning for remodeling the first floor of the library is underway. The goal is to move some things and to have space for seating.

Things are in place for the Planter's Day parade (June 15th).

Justin requested money for cupcakes and juice for the Book Mark Celebration. Joyce made the motion to allow him to spend the money. Noel seconded. Passed.
