Fundraising: Virginia reported on the bingo progress. We will have a Bingo meeting on Wed June 16 at 7PM at the Museum in order to finalize plans for the Bingo fundraiser, which is to be held Friday June 18 at the school commons at 7PM. Doors will open at 6:30.

John Stark gave a brief rundown on the saga of the museum directional sign. He is working with the city to find an appropriate place for it.

Geri now has her June calendar filled for people to open the museum on Saturdays for 12 to 4PM.

John Stark said that he will try to find an old car for the Planter's Days parade.
